From our Worshipful Master, Eric Desmond

My Dear Brothers:

As 2025 draws to a close, I would like to extend my heartfelt appreciation to each Brother. I was honored to be elected to the Oriental Chair for this past year, and it is hoped that each of you reflect on the past months with a similar fondness.

As I expressed at the beginning of my service as Worshipful Master to Temple Lodge No. 16, it was the sincere hope of the Officers that each Brother would continue to hold a beloved place in their hearts for our Lodge, and that through our efforts we would encourage Brothers to participate

more earnestly, more forthrightly and more enthusiastically as we move forward.
